To All PAGA Chapter

It has come to my attention that some chapters are not in compliance with the National Constitution relating to Article III - Membership. I request all chapters must abide to Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, & 8.

Article III, Section 3 – All local chapters are subject to the rules and regulations of the National Organization.

Article III, Section 4 – Total membership of each chapter must maintain at least twenty (20) members at all times. A member in bad standing with one chapter may not be admitted as a member in any other chapter.

Article III, Section 5 – Yearly dues must be paid up in accordance with National Constitution will be based on the first Minimax calculation of the year. Dues must be accompanied by a roster of the members included in the dues. Minimax Computing Corporation shall be the official handicap agency of this organization.

Article III, Section 7 – Each chapters must submit to the National Secretary a roster of their officers and their addresses and telephone number soon after their local elections. .

Article III, Section 8 – All chapters shall hold elections of officers at their discretion and they shall take office in accordance with their local Constitution and By-Laws.

In addition, no chapter should have their address directed to a home address but rather to a Post Office box.

I direct all chapters to take action and respond immediately.
